Treasure Coast Chapter Florida Engineering Society

1. Each angler will attempt to weigh in 1 legal Snook and 1 legal Redfish. All State and Federal Laws Apply. Two categories will be awarded one for heaviest legal fish in each category.
2. Lines in the water 7:00 AM.
3. Weigh station opens at 3:00 PM and closes at 4:00 PM. This means you must be checked in with whoever is keeping the weight log. Weigh-in location Indian Riverside Park. Lat. 27° 13' 29.55" N Long 80° 12' 34.47" W
4. The Weigh Masters word is final.
5. All baits are legal (live, artificial, dead.) All State and Federal Laws Apply.
6. Dead fish can be weighed in at no penalty. Release of a live fish will be a 1 pound bonus. Dead fish must be edible (properly kept on ice). If you leave fish out to spoil, you will be disqualified.
7. If you weigh in an illegal fish, you will be disqualified.
9. If you are caught or if we have a legitimate reason to believe that you or your team cheated you will be disqualified.
10. Disabled tournament boats that do not make the 4:00 PM weigh in will not be allowed to weigh their fish.
11. Teams that help a disabled boat and arrive at weigh in after 4:00 PM will be allowed to weigh their fish. However they need to make contact with Noah Handley at (863) 634-6189 or David Andre (772) 408-2735 ASAP!
12. "Snoopy Rod Calcutta" - Heaviest Single Fish Weight of Any Legal Species caught on a Children's Cartoon Character Rod & Reel Combo (Overall length not to exceed 36", original reel must be used, relining is allowed). Only Cartoon Character Rod & Reel Combos are allowed. Angler must present Rod & Reel Combo at weigh in to verify it was used in original configuration. Tournament Fish may be caught on "Snoopy Rod Calcutta" and weight will count for both categories.
